A. Foreword

Taitung Forest District Office has governed approximate 230,000 hectares of national forest (including the protected forest outside the district), taking up about 10.9% of total forest area island wide. Forest may purify the air, regulate floods, prevent landslides, protect wild animals and plants and provide recreation resources, so it is closely linked with the public's lives.

This area covers tropical, warm, temperate and cold forests. They have cradled diversified animals and plants. Primarily due to its slower development, greater space of natural forest land has been preserved in this area. Besides animals and plants, it has other abundant terrestrial heat, landscapes and recreation resources. To comply with the service conviction of "Innovation, Progression, and Professionalism", this office has vowed to protect forest resources as well as restore natural environment, carry out the participation of forestry community, fortify natural forest education, promote forest recreation and elevate tourism quality and service level, so forest sustainability can be maintained and the service goal of public welfare will be achieved.
